MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Felix Bowen Price respectfully requests an extension of a **final thirty (30) days, until February 6, 2019**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Felix Bowen Price respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Thomas Tiedemann v. State in the Supreme Court on November 26, 2018. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Carlon Eugene Weathers, Jr. in the Court of Appeals on November 20, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of James Allen Johnson v. State in the Supreme Court on November 20, 2018. Counsel filed the brief of appellant pursuant to White v. State in the case of State v. Harry James Roller in the Supreme Court on November 14, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari, accompanying appendix and supplemental appendix in the case of Harry Roller James v. State in the Supreme Court on November 14, 2018. Counsel filed the Johnson petition and accompanying appendix in the case of Joe Louis Bailey v. State in the Supreme Court on November 13, 2018. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of In the Interest of: Jairus J. V. before the Court of Appeals on November 7, 2018.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload

5: Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.




