I'm writing in regards to an extra extension of 45 days. I previously wrote explaining my situation. On November 30, 2018, I received a letter that stated that I had 45 days from the date of the letter to file my Pro Se response to the petition filed by my counsel. The date of this letter is November 6, 2018. If I received the letter on November 30, 2018, which was mailed out to me on November 20, 2018, and it is saying that I have 45 days to file my Pro Se response from the date of the letter, that would put my deadline date at December 21, 2018.

Under Houston v. Lack, 487 U.S. 266, 108 S.Ct. 2379, 101 L.Ed.2d 245, states that the time of appeals to be filed, pro se prisoner's notice of appeal starts at moment of delivery to prison authorities. Now, if I received my letter on the 30th of November and 45 days after that would put my dead line around January 15, 2019. I wrote a letter on November 30, 2018 along with the date of the envelope and letter I received showing and explaining everything and asking for an extension of time because I'm in a locked down unit and we are not allowed but 2 days a week for the law library. I haven't been to the law library since December 19, 2018 and as of now, we're on an institutional lockdown which we've been on since January 3, 2019. The letter that I received on December 6, 2018, states that I was granted an extension which extends to January 15, 2019. How is that possible? What about my original deadline date? Please, please correct this unfortunate circumstance and please give me the correct original deadline along with the extension time that I need

to file my Pro Se petition. This is something that I'm asking in the interest of Justice.
