

Dear Mr. Crockett:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected in their entirety within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or the appeal will be dismissed:

- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. The proof of service must show the names and contact information to the other parties to the appeal and the date you mailed a copy of the notice of appeal to the opposing parties,
- If you want this Court to consider your request to proceed in forma pauperis in this Court, you must serve and file an original motion in accordance with Rule 240, SCACR.
- You must provide proof that you have filed a copy of the notice of appeal with the Clerk of Court in Spartanburg County.
