Dear MR. Shearouse:

I asked appointed attorney to petition the Supreme Court for bail pending appellate review. SCACR, 243(K). "A post-conviction relief applicant may be admitted to bail after the service of appeal by either the applicant or the State." Counsel wrote a letter stating: he would not petition for bail because I am indigent and because I lost in PCR court, inter alia. I was informed by this Court, August 31, 2018, after I attempted to file a pro se petition for bail pending appellate review, that "substantive documents filed pro se by a person represented by counsel are not to be accepted unless submitted by counsel." Miller v. State, cite as 697 S.E. 2d 527 (2010). This prejudice me because my constitutional right to court-access has been violated (U.S. Const. Amend. 1). Moreover, "A lawyer ~~must also~~ shall act with reasonable diligence and promptness in representing a client." (Rules of Professional Conduct, Rule 1.3, RPC, Rule 407, SCACR) Also, "A lawyer must also act with commitment and dedication to the interests of the client and with zeal in advocacy upon the clients behalf." I demand this Court to compel appointed attorney to petition the Supreme Court for bail pending appellate review and follow South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, on my behalf.
