Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing your appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected in their entirety within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your initial brief will not be considered and the appeal dismissed:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption should appear exactly as follows:

Navy Federal Credit Union, Respondent,

v.

William T. Simmons, III; Laura Ferguson; and Ford Motor Credit Company,
LLC, Defendants,

Of whom Laura Ferguson is the Appellant.

- It is not necessary to use a blue cover when filing the brief in initial form.
- The initial brief is not in proper format. Specifically, the content of the brief should be double spaced and page 9 of the brief should not be included after the conclusion page. See Rule 208(b)(1)(A), SCACR.
- You have included the name Kelley Y. Woody on the cover of your brief. Ms. Woody has not made an appearance in this case and should not be included on the cover of the brief or record on appeal.
- You must serve and file an amended appellant's initial brief incorporating all of these corrections within ten days.
