MOTION TO ALLOW LATE ORDERING OF TRANSCRIPT



- The notice of appeal in this case was filed on December 10, 2018.
- Because the hearing giving rise to the transcript was scheduled specially, the identity of the court reporter was not available via the online terms of court calendar.
- Immediately after the Christmas holidays, the trial judge's office assisted appellant's counsel in identifying the correct court reporter.
- On January 3, 2019, the transcript was ordered. See Exhibit A.

- Notice of the ordering of the transcript was provided to the Court of Appeals and all opposing counsel on January 8, 2019. See Exhibit B.
- Notice of the ordering of the transcript was not provided to the Office of Court Administration, but that oversight has been remedied as of today. See Exhibit C.
- Appellant received the transcript on January 10, 2019.






