

ORDER

Appellant has again served and filed a notice of appeal from the master-in-equity's writ of assistance. Our review of this matter indicates that Appellant failed to appeal the underlying order of foreclosure and the property was sold by judicial sale on May 1, 2017. Thus, the parties' rights to the subject property are settled, and this appeal is moot. *See Mathis v. S.C. State Highway Dep't*, 260 S.C. 344, 346, 195 S.E.2d 713, 715 (1973) ("A case becomes moot when judgment, if rendered, will have no practical legal effect upon [any] existing controversy. This is true when some event occurs making it impossible for [the] reviewing Court to grant effectual relief."). Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
