COUNT ONE

ATTEMPTED MURDER

That Malik Jabree Singleton did in Sumter on or about 2016-12-14, violate Section 16-3-29 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina (1976), as amended, in that the said Malik Jabree Singleton did with intent to kill, attempt to kill another person, to wit: Travis Dow, with malice aforethought, either express or implied, by shooting the victim in the head with a handgun


COUNT TWO

POSSESSION OF A WEAPON DURING THE COMMISSION
OF A VIOLENT CRIME

That Malik Jabree Singleton did in Sumter County, on or about December 14, 2016, possess a firearm, or visibly display what appeared to be a firearm, or visibly displayed a knife, during the commission or attempted commission of a violent crime, in violation of Section 16-23-0490, S.
