Dear Ms. Kitchens:

Despite numerous attempts to have the court/clerk send correspondence for service to the correct address, which is 1459 River Highway, Mooresville, NC 28117, the court/clerk continues to fail to address this causing me, a pro se litigant, to not be properly notified. Therefore, I failed to receive your January 15, 2019 correspondence until January 27, 2019, when I happened to be in Myrtle Beach on unrelated business. (See Related Enclosures).

At that point, when I got home to Mooresville, NC, I checked on C-track. I noticed that correspondence that I sent to the court regarding the final brief was not listed as having been received by the court. This situation combined with my inability to obtain council and other matters related to this case, has deprived me of my due process rights.

I was in the process of attempting to draft a motion responsive to the final brief when I received this letter of January 15, 2019, which has completely put me in a situation of an inability to attempt to pursue a legal remedy.

I am a lay person who has attempted to engage legal counsel and have been unable to do so to address this complex legal matter. The court not listing the correspondence that I have sent

and the continual confusion of dates and addresses by the court has further hampered any ability I may have had to attempt to litigate this on a pro se basis which I am being forced to do, despite my repeated attempts to the contrary. (See attached partial list of attorneys, I have attempted to engage).

I will be calling your office tomorrow to discuss 1) Getting proper dates of and calendar deadlines worked out and 2) to advise that I will be filing a Motion with the court on this case prior to attempting to file the final brief on a pro se basis.

I am only seeking to restore and ensure my due process rights in this court.


Dear Ms. Kitchens:
