ORDER

Petitioner has filed a notice of appeal from the denial of his application for post-conviction relief. The South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense, Division of Appellate Defense, is currently representing Petitioner in this matter, but seeks appointment of outside counsel due to a potential appearance of a conflict of interest. The State does not oppose the request.

The motion for appointment of outside counsel is granted, and the Division of Appellate Defense is relieved from representation of Petitioner. Donae Minor, who represented Petitioner before the circuit court, is appointed to represent Petitioner in this matter. The Division of Appellate Defense shall remain associated for the limited purpose of paying for any necessary transcript(s) and providing copies of the petition, appendix, and briefs.
