prison.

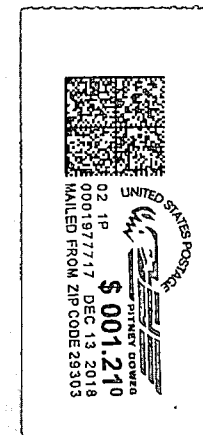
