Upon reviewing your attempted corrections post marked January 17, 2019, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this appeal will be dismissed:

- The order challenged on appeal provided contains additional writing and markings. The order must not contain any additional writing or markings. You must provide a true copy of the order challenged on appeal without additional writing and markings.
- The correction fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.
- The proof of service provided is incorrect. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. An example of a proof of service has been attached for your convenience.

- The proof of service provided does not indicate that the notice of appeal has been served on the agency and/or the Administrative Law Court as required by Rule 203(e), SCACR.
