That OMAR RICK WILLIAMS did in Florence County on or about November 26, 2017 commit an unlawful act of injury to Walter Treadway which resulted in great bodily injury or the act was accomplished by means likely to produce death or great bodily injury to the victim, to wit: by shooting the victim, requiring him to seek emergency medical attention; in violation of Section 16-3-600(B), S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

months/years and subject to South Carolina Department of Probation, Parole and Pardon Services standard conditions of probation, which are incorporated by reference.
