## ORDER

This appeal arises out of a guilty plea. The appellant was sentenced on January 9, 2019. The notice of appeal was not served until January 23, 2019. Pursuant to Rules 203(b)(2) and Rule 263 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the deadline for service of the notice of appeal was January 22, 2019. Because the notice of appeal was not timely served, this appeal is dismissed. *See State v. Devore*, 416 S.C. 115, 784 S.E.2d 690 (Ct. App. 2016) (noting the appellate court lacks jurisdiction in the absence of a timely-served notice of appeal and that the appellate court may not extend or ignore the deadline for service of the notice). The remittitur will be sent pursuant to Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
