MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Charles Green v. State with the Supreme Court on January 28, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Demossio Valentine v. State with the Supreme Court on January 18, 2019. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of Eric Spratt v. The State on January 9, 2019 with the Court of Appeals. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Joseph Chappell with the Court of Appeals on January 7, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Lavonte Fabor v. State in the Supreme Court on December 28, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in the case of Christopher Cobb v. State with the Supreme Court on December 21, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. John Hart with the Court of Appeals on December 17, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in the case of Cliston Bellamy v. State with the Supreme Court on December 12, 2018.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.


