Dear Deputy Clerk Allen:

In response to your letter dated January 23, 2019, I have no personal information concerning the Bankruptcy of Robert G. Bone and his wife. I know that there was a confirmation hearing of some type on May 3, 2018, to approve a 5-year payment plan, and in checking, it was still active as of January 31, 2019.

In that I was pursuing a case involving a breach of a Conservator Fiduciary Duty by Robert G. Bone, involving substantial assets of the disabled Albert D. Bone, which my client, Vivy Haynes Bone, as ex-wife of Albert D. Bone, is entitled to by the Order of the Aiken County Family Court. I do not know much about bankruptcy, but I believe if such conduct and obligations had been listed, it would have impacted whether the bankruptcy would have been approved.

My assistant discovered on the internet that Robert G. Bone and his wife had filed for a Chapter 13 Bankruptcy in 2018 without listing the Court case and any assets due to Albert D. Bone and thus to Vivy Haynes Bone, which were clearly established by the Tax Returns filed by Robert G. Bone for the years 2010 through 2014.

I called the Lawyer to Lawyer, and was advised to send documents to the Trustee Stevenson. Not wanting to run into any impropriety I sent the documents to Mr. Bone's Bankruptcy Attorney Joseph E. Mitchell, III, P.O. Box 2504, Augusta GA, 30903, prior to sending the letter to Trustee Stevenson.

Not receiving any satisfactory response from Attorney Mitchell, I prepared a letter to Trustee Stevenson, with a copy to Mr. Mitchell, but before I mailed the letter, I received your letter of January 23, 2019, wanting to know about the Bankruptcy.

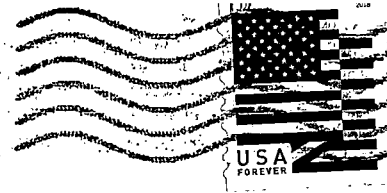
