DESIGNATION OF MATTER TO BE INCLUDED IN RECORD ON APPEAL


Appellant hereby moves pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, for an extension to March 8, 2019, of the time in which to serve and file Appellant’s Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal in this case. The grounds for this motion are that there is good cause to grant the requested extension, as the following shows:

1. Appellant was *pro se* for most of the time that this case was pending at the circuit court level.
2. Appellant’s undersigned counsel ordered the transcript at the commencement of this appeal; however, that was somewhat unnecessary, since Appellant, *pro se*, had already ordered the transcript.

3. The undersigned counsel has not received the transcript from the court reporter; however, Appellant himself received the transcript in December of 2018.
4. Appellant's counsel now has a copy of the transcript that he received directly from Appellant.
5. To deal with this, an extension of Appellant's briefing and designation deadline is required.
6. This is the first extension that Appellant has sought in this appeal.
7. Appellant's counsel believes there is good cause to grant the requested extension of this deadline to March 8, 2019.

WHEREFORE Appellant prays for an order extending the time in which to serve and file Appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal to March 8, 2019.


