**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME  
TO FILE FINAL BRIEFS**

Respondents Nationwide Mutual Insurance Company ("Nationwide"), Titan Indemnity Company ("Titan"), Rick Skurko and Tracey Peer, by and through their undersigned counsel, hereby respectfully move for an extension of time to file and serve their Final Brief until the Court rules on the previously filed Motion to Strike the Record on Appeal. The undersigned filed with the Court a Motion to Strike the Record on Appeal on January 31, 2019, and that Motion is pending before this Court. The undersigned recognizes that such a Motion does not automatically stay the time for filing the Final Briefs, but respectfully requests the Court enter a stay and allow Respondents to file their Final Briefs after the Court has ruled on the Motion to Strike, and, if so ordered, after Appellant has filed and served a new Record on Appeal that complies with the SCACR. The undersigned makes this Motion believing the delayed submission of the Final Briefs would prevent extraneous filings with the Court – if Respondents filed their Final Brief before the Court granted the Motion to Strike, for instance, Respondents

would be required to file a second Final Brief upon receipt of the Corrected Record on Appeal. Entering a stay for filing the Final Briefs would allow the Court to decide the Motion to Strike without unnecessarily receiving briefing that may be irrelevant after the Court's decision on that Motion.

Accordingly, Respondents Nationwide, Titan, Skurko, and Peer respectfully request this Court grant the above-described extension of time to file and serve their Final Brief until such time as the Court deems appropriate after its decision on the Motion to Strike the Record on Appeal. Counsel has consulted with the attorneys for the other Respondents, and they consent to this Motion. However, because Appellant is pro se, Counsel has not contacted her for consent and does not believe her consent would be forthcoming.


