MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF  
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Derrick L. Walker respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until March 11, 2019**, in which to file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari with the accompanying appendix in the case of Doni Terrelle Anderson v. The State with this Court on December 28, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari with the accompanying appendix in the case of James L. Moore v. The State with this Court on December 13, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of Robert Powell with the Court of Appeals on November 28, 2018.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request as shown by signature below.


