**PETITION FOR LEAVE TO FILE
SUPPLEMENTAL APPENDIX**

NOW COMES, Petitioner, acting *pro se*, in the above captioned matter seeking leave to file a Supplemental Appendix in this appeal. As noted in her Petition for Writ of Certiorari, at the time the Petition was filed, Petitioner did not have a transcript of the Common Pleas hearing held on her appeal in this fee dispute matter. She discovered that her staff had not ordered that record while putting together the Appendix for this appeal. Applicant's Petition for Writ of Certiorari was filed on November 5, 2018. Petitioner submitted a request for an expedited copy of that short transcript on November 8, 2018. Despite being advised by email that the Court Reporter hoped to provide by the end of that week, Petitioner did not receive the complete transcript from the Court Reporter until February 5, 2019.

As is noted in the Certiorari Petition filed in this matter, Petitioner's appeal from the ruling of the circuit court on her appeal from the Fee Dispute Committee was dismissed by the Court of Appeals before the Initial Brief of Petitioner was filed. There was, therefore, no Record on Appeal

filed in that Court. Respondent has not, to the knowledge of Petitioner, filed a Return to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari filed in this matter, nor has he received an extension of time in which to do so. In the interest of a full record in this appeal, Petitioner now asks that she be permitted to submit a Supplemental Appendix in this matter consisting of the transcript of the October 27, 2017, hearing held before the Honorable G. Thomas Cooper, Jr., presiding circuit court judge.

For the convenience of the Court, the original, unbound copy and one bound copy, of her proposed Supplemental Appendix. Respondent has been served with a copy of this Petition, and the proposed Supplemental Appendix, by placement in the United States Mail Service on today's date.


