ORDER

After careful consideration, Appellant's motion to proceed in forma pauperis is denied. *See Martin v. State*, 321 S.C. 533, 535, 471 S.E.2d 134, 134-35 (1995) ("In the absence of a statutory provision allowing the general waiver of filing fees, we conclude motions to proceed in forma pauperis may only be granted where specifically authorized by statute or required by constitutional provisions."); *Sullivan v. S.C. Dep't of Corr.*, 355 S.C. 437, 445, 586 S.E.2d 124, 128 (2003) ("There is no statutory provision that permits the waiver of filing fees for an appeal brought under the APA . . ."); *Ortwein v. Schwab*, 410 U.S. 656, 656 (1973) (ruling there was no constitutional requirement that filing fees be waived in an appeal concerning the reduction in welfare benefits).
