MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Darrell Griffin respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until March 18, 2019**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Darrell Griffin respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Julia Shawnette Gorman v. The State with this Court on January 7, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Tyrone Davis v. The State with this Court on January 7, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Alexander Maldonado Coreano v. The State with this Court on December 17, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Billy L. Alford v. The State with this Court on December 17, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Orin Jerrell Kemp with the Court of Appeals on December 7, 2018.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.


