I have been a Pro Sec during the past 17 months; Case number 2017-cp-0386. At this point I cannot truly understand the South Carolina Court System and its ability to deny a United States Citizen its right to a fair trial among his/her peers including determining me GUILTY and rendering damages as such.

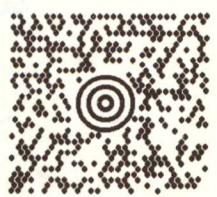

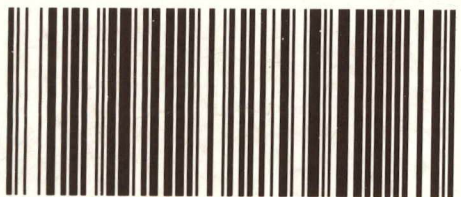

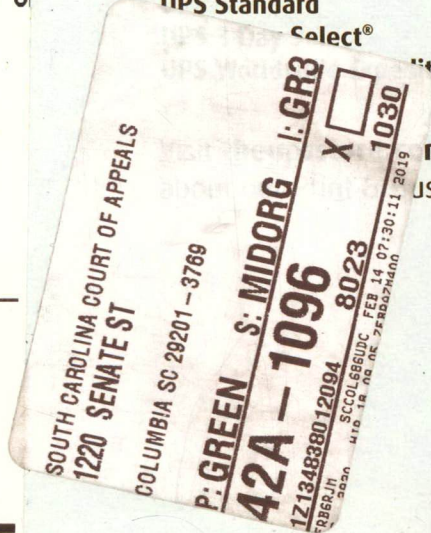
