

On December 21, 2018, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of Matter in The State v. Darius Walker with the Court of Appeals. On December 11, 2018, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in David Aldean Dickerson v. The State with the Supreme Court. On December 6, 2018, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Dominique Agurs v. The State with the Supreme Court. On November 30, 2018, counsel was a guest speaker during the breakout session at the Presenting Cases to the Appellate Courts continuing legal education seminar. On November 26, 2018, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Leon Simmons v. The State with the Supreme Court. On November 16, 2018, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompany appendix in Gene Tony Cooper v. The State with the Supreme Court.


4. Matthew Buchanan, Esquire, has received a copy of this extension request by email, and has forwarded his consent to this request.
