At a Court of General Sessions, convened on September 8, 2016 the Grand Jurors of SUMTER County present upon their oath:

COUNT ONE

That Shawn Douglas Custer did in Sumter County, on or about September 21, 2015, with criminal or fraudulent intent, buy receive or possess stolen goods, chattels or other property knowing or having reason to believe such property was stolen, valued at ten thousand (\$10,000.00) dollars or more, in violation of Section 16-13-180(A), S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

COUNT TWO

That Shawn Douglas Custer did in Sumter County, on or about September 21, 2015, with criminal or fraudulent intent, buy, receive or possess stolen goods, chattels, or other property knowing or having reason to believe such property was stolen, valued at more than two thousand dollars but less than ten thousand dollars, in violation of Section 16-13-0180(A), S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.
