MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI AND  
ACCOMPANYING APPENDIX

Counsel for Joey L. Clark respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Leon M. Davis v. The State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on January 11, 2019. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Jarod Tarrell Bostick with the Court of Appeals on January 7, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of John Fitzgerald Kennedy v. The State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on December 31, 2018.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.


WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty day extension, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this




