MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Vanessa Laquetta Frayer respectfully requests an extension of thirty days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:


1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Vanessa Laquetta Frayer respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. On February 19, 2019, counsel filed the supplemental brief of appellant in The State v. Jonathan Donell Rhodes with the Court of Appeals. On February 13, 2019, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Furman E. Taylor v. The State with the Supreme Court. On February 8, 2019, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Oriental J. Charley v. The State with the Supreme Court. On January 31, 2019, counsel had an oral argument in State v. Wayland Purnell before the Supreme Court. On January 24, 2019, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari, brief of appellant pursuant to White v. State, and accompanying appendix in Antonio Ochoa-Tavera v. The State with the Supreme Court. On January 14, 2019, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of Matter in The State v. Montrelle Lamont Campbell with the Court of Appeals. On December 21, 2018, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of Matter in The State v. Darius Walker with the Court of Appeals. On December 11, 2018, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in David Aldean Dickerson v. The State with the Supreme Court. On December 6, 2018, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Dominique Agurs v. The State with the Supreme Court. On November 30, 2018, counsel was a guest speaker during the breakout session at the Presenting Cases to the Appellate Courts continuing legal education seminar. On November 26, 2018, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Leon Simmons v. The State with the Supreme Court. On November 16, 2018, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompany appendix in Gene Tony Cooper v. The State with the Supreme Court.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.






