Dear Your Honorable Judge,

I'm writing because new information in my appeal case has come up.

Greenville News Updated 6:08 p.m. Est Jan. 30, 2019 in South Carolina

- 1) Green told Deputies the truck wasn't his. It was his mom's.
- 2) On July 11, 2017 Deputies noted the truck was registered to his Mother in an incident report.
- 3) Flythe-Harkless said she even called the Sheriff's Office to see how she could get her truck returned
- 4) But when it came time for prosecutors to seek forfeiture of the truck in court, Flythe-Harkless wasn't named as a defendant in civil action, so she was never notified of a hearing, Instead, the summons was sent to her son (me), who was ^{still} in jail
- 5) Twice her son wrote to the assistant solicitor assigned to the case Jonathan Gregory, to tell him the vehicle wasn't his and to contact his mother at the address he provided
- 6) I would like to know what's going (sic) because he's acting like they didn't know the vehicle was hers, Green wrote in second letter
- 7) By then it was November, Tonja Flythe-Harkless had been without the truck for 5 months. I have not once yet been sent any paperwork, any court work saying they wanted to take my \$(mother) truck
- 8) A month later, Gregory filed a motion asking a judge to declare forfeiture ~~of~~ on the trucks because no one had come forward ^{*} (Judge Said NO) ^{*}
- 9) Then the judge told him what to do ^{*} She told the Solicitor's office to add Flythe-Harkless as an interested party in the case ^{*}. when prosecutors finally did months later and after another letter from Green (me) - she ~~is~~ still hadn't been served a court summons.

9) The ~~Evening~~ Sun Nothing happen until a Greenville News reporter met with 13th circuit solicitor Walt Wilkins and asked about the case on April 4, 2018

The next day, a summons was mailed to Flythe-Harkless via certified mail

This was written by a Greenville reporter. Here are some facts as to the time length of ~~time~~ their filing the paper work in a timely manner. Here also was extra information unknown to me about the Head Solicitor Walt Wilkins didn't send my mother the proper paper work until after the reporter went to talk to him. Also Mr. Gregory knew who truck/vehicle was and still tried to get a forfeiture done under the nose/back door of the owner. The judge said no to the forfeiture but ~~never~~ never release the truck back to the rightful owner. Instead the Judge told the solicitor's office what they need to do (this is not a neutral and detached Judge). This wasn't known at forfeiture hearing (by me nor my mother). The court reporter also let the cat out of the bag by saying "She" the Judge. The Judge in my ~~case~~ ^{hearing} for ~~a~~ ^{the} forfeiture was a male Alex Kinlaw. Now wheather he also knew of this information, i'm not sure, but this adds weight on the case. As to the time they (solicitor) took to do the paper work properly. Stated Petitioner must submit to the court within a reasonable time period. ① The petitioner shall identify any other persons known to the petitioner to have interest(s) in the property (done late and he knew already). ② The petition shall also ~~include~~ ^{include} the person in whose name the conveyance is registered and the person who holds the title to the conveyance (which is Tonja Flythe-Harkless and this information was in the possession solicitor knowledge from start 7-11-17 to 9-00-17 to 10-00-17 to ~~9-00-17~~ through 4-00-2018). He had plante of time (39-15-1195(G)). These are 3 points in my appeal petition that are shown in this article wrote by a New Reporter of Greenville County. Thank you for your time.

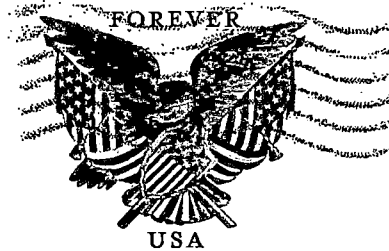
