(843) 270-4429, owner Ms Paulette Jenkins. Fozzy and her children left the area on Friday Oct. 6, 2016, going to Greenville, S.C. Ms Seabrook first day on the job Aug. 18, 2016.

I called Dr. Freeman: "Is there someone you can send out?" I experience high anxiety, A-FIB - Cardio and pulmonary problems. Vertigo is also a problem. I have back-up for my Pace maker machine - home monitor, C-Pap (8 hr) and portable oxygen but at 75 years old, you can be afraid, alone. John's Island does not have a "public" shelter for residents.

Dr. Freeman sent on Cape Jeannette Langley-Henson from Jeannette's Loving Care In-Homecare (843) 708-9098 - (843) 709-7086 - Seemerville. My lights went out Friday evening. Mrs. Langley and my daughter, Annette Keesee, came to my rescue. Ms. Langley came here, with supplies, a true caregiver and professional.

She returned to my home 11 days later! She said she still had her job!

Ms. Langley has shown me  
heartfelt love and compassion  
She and her care giver she hired  
for me are dedicated professionals,  
at all times. Ms Langley gives of  
herself with her compassion care,  
she has been here on Sundays and  
Saturday giving personal care

me much stress. Ms Langley  
comes with a warm personality.

I called Dr. Bruce Freeman MD - case manager, (843) 475-3027. "Was Mrs Langley lost her business licenses and who will pay Annette, my care giver?" Dr Freeman told me "Mrs Langley lost her licenses on the 21st. she knew she had no licenses. The state will not pay your care giver if the provider (Mrs Langley) has no licenses?" I called Mrs Langley "I have my licenses." "I will pay Annette."

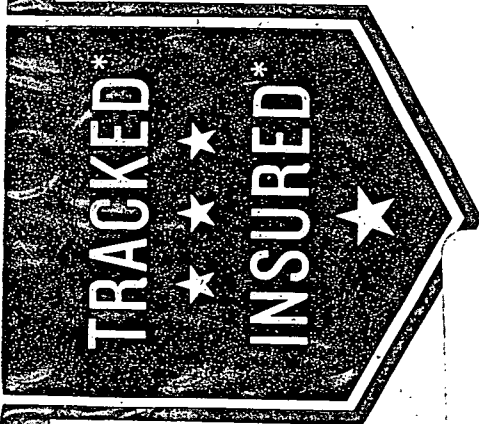

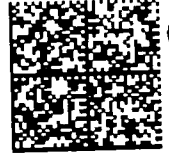
