I am very saddened to inform you of a very unfortunate and unforeseen situation that is occurring in my life at this very moment. My daddy, Mr. Eddie Holloway Sr. is on his deathbed. All life support has been removed, so it is only a matter of time when he leaves us. My Dad is a very strong man, so only GOD knows when he will take his last breath.

Please, be patient with me for this is the worse and hardest thing I've ever faced. I am the only daughter with four brothers. One brother has snatched our father from my care on May 11, 2018. There was a Court Order for That Brother to return our dad back to my care by May 19, 2018. He hid our dad and did not obey the Court Order. I feel that this Probate Court failed my father by not Enforcing this Order. Now, in less than a year, our dad is dying. I have been taking care of our father's health and running errands for him and my stepmother, since 2015.

In my heart this was intentional lack for proper care. I have proof of that, however I am so emotionally devastated, that I don't know where to begin. Just before every appointed hearing, my dad was too sick to appear in court. On February the 27th, 2019 at 10am, this will be the third scheduled court hearing. I guess even when dad past away, a Conservators needs to be appointed. Please, forgive me, for troubling you with my problems.

Due to many unexpected expenses, I am humbly asking for a motion to proceed in Forma Pauperis. Also, I am asking for a motion to file fewer (6) copies into The South Carolina Court of Appeals, for The Honorable Judges.

I am Pleading for a **90-day extension** to submit the record on appeal, the designation of materials asked for and the final brief.

Appellant's Materials Asked for Are:

- the Itemized Statement of bills with the total cost from Blue Cross, Blue Shield Subrogation Statements.
- Lynne Johnson's (the defendant) ten-year driving record
- police report citation
- the traffic ticket she received from the accident on February 5, 2011 the ticket was giving to her on February 6, 2011
- the best evidence of original photographs of the scene.

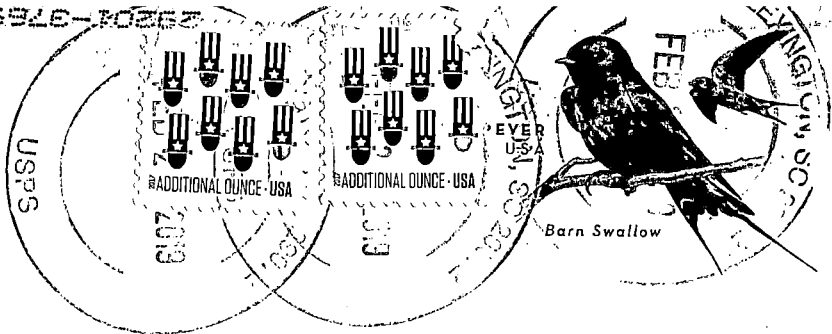
