Dear Ms. Dinkins-Robinson:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- Pursuant to Rule 203(d)(1)(B), SCACR, the notice of appeal shall be filed with the clerk of the appellate court and the clerk of the trial court.
- According to Rule 203, SCACR, a notice of appeal must only include the name of the court from which the appeal is taken; the judge's name; the lower court docket number; the date of the order being appealed; a statement of when the appealing party received the decision from which the appeal is taken; the name of the appealing party; and the names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all attorneys of record and the names of the party or parties represented by each. An amended notice of appeal must be filed that includes only this information.
