
Under Rules 240 and 263(b) of the SCACR, Appellant moves for a ten (10) day extension of time in which to file its Initial Reply Brief.





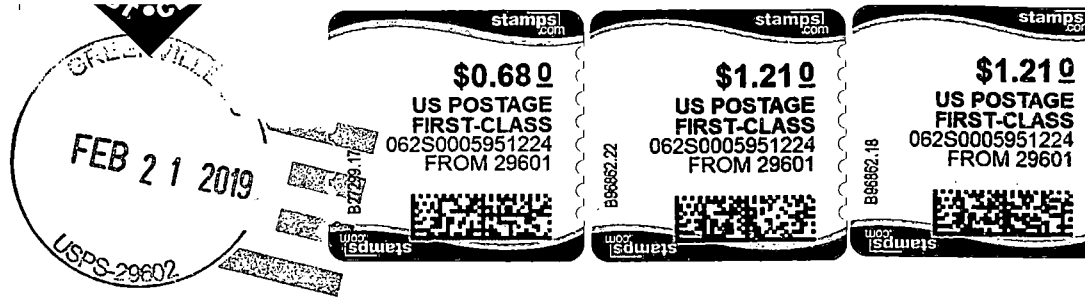
