THE COURT: All right. The next matter before the Court is the probation violation hearing on Kenneth Edward Hampton. The No. Has a copy of two 1106's, one in Case number 10-GS-32-654 and the other in 10-GS-32-020.

Madame Clerk?

KENNETH EDWARD HAMPTON,

having been duly sworn, testified as follows:

THE COURT: The Court will mark both 1106's -- the one in Case No. 654 as Court's Exhibit No. 1 and the one in Case No. 020 as Court's Exhibit No. 2 and make them a part of the record.

(WHEREUPON Court's Exhibits 1 and 2 were marked into evidence.)

THE COURT: The 1106 indicates that in Case No. 10-GS-32-654, the defendant was sentenced for forgery by Judge McIntosh on February 24, 2010, given five years, suspended upon time served, which is twenty-eight days and placed on probation for five years.

The 1106 in the Case No. 10-GS-32-020 indicates the defendant was sentenced for forgery by Judge Keesley on 1/27 of 2010, given five years suspended upon one hundred twenty-eight days time served and five years probation.

The Court also has a copy of two arrest warrants, both dated October 8th, 2012, and both served on October

1 the -- I'm sorry, December 17 of 2012, and thus this Court
2 has jurisdiction on the matter.

3 Mr. Hampton, the department alleges and claims that
4 you violated the terms and conditions of your probation by
5 failing to report as instructed and failing to report on
6 4/19/2012 or any time thereafter. You haven't worked
7 diligently at a lawful occupation. You're in arrears on
8 your fines, your restitution and your drug test fees, and
9 these are the things the department alleges that you did to
10 violate the terms and conditions of your probation.

11 Do you understand what the allegations of the
12 arrest warrants are?

13 **THE DEFENDANT:** Yes, sir.

14 **THE COURT:** You understand that you have a right to
15 present any testimony to me that you wish to present and
16 that I'll hear from you in that regard in a few minutes?

17 **MR. HAMPTON:** Yes, sir.

18 **THE COURT:** And you also have the right to be
19 represented by an attorney. I see you are hear with Mr.
20 Drylie. Have you had a chance to talk with Mr. Drylie
21 about those violations.

22 **MR. HAMPTON:** Yes, sir.

23 **THE COURT:** And you have the right to appeal from
24 any decision that I make and you must do that within ten
25 days. You understand that?

1 MR. HAMPTON: Yes, sir.

2 THE COURT: All right. Anything you'd like to add
3 to the 1106?

4 THE PROBATION OFFICER: No, sir, nothing at this
5 time, Your Honor.

6 THE COURT: All right. Mr. Drylie?

7 MR. DRYLIE: Thank you, Your Honor. Mr. Hampton is
8 30 years old. He went to the 11th grade. He does do
9 painting. I want to let you know a couple of the -- a
10 couple of the circumstances surrounding his not reporting.
11 He actually left the state -- his sister was dying and he
12 went down there and he just didn't come back. And he
13 realizes that was wrong. I talked with the agent about
14 this matter, Your Honor, and we'd ask for a partial
15 revocation and credit him time served. He does have some
16 mental health issues, Your Honor and I think the agent,
17 Mr. Hampton, and I are all in agreement that he is probably
18 not a good candidate for probation.

19 We'd ask that you partially revoke and terminate
20 the probation and credit him with time served. He has been
21 in jail since December 17th. I think he was actually in
22 jail for about a week down in Georgia before that, which is
23 where they picked him up in Atlanta. He was down in
24 Atlanta with his family.

25 THE COURT: He's been in jail since December 17th,

1 of 2012?

2 MR. DRYLIE: Yes, Your Honor.

3 THE COURT: All right. Mr. Hampton? Anything
4 you'd like to tell me?

5 THE DEFENDANT: I just want to apologize to the
6 Court for wasting your time. And the circumstances, I
7 might could have done things better than -- I actually did
8 talk to my agent at the time and he didn't grant me
9 anything. I was trying to get him to understand that my
10 sister was dying of AIDS and she was my mother's only
11 daughter and I'm my mother's only son and things got
12 complicated; so I went down there thinking I was going to
13 be able to come back, but it didn't happen like that. I
14 stayed with her until she passed October 5th, 2012. But
15 other than that, I'm sorry. I apologize.

16 THE COURT: All right. Well the -- of course, the
17 department can't do anything to supervise you if you take
18 off. So -- I've told a lot of people this, the easiest
19 thing you have to do on probation is report and they'll
20 work with you most of the time, but if you don't report,
21 there's not a thing in the world the probation department
22 can do.

23 Of course, this is not the first time you have
24 failed to report. I see on the 1106 that you failed to
25 report multiple -- prior violations for failure to report.

1 You absconded from supervision.

2 How much time does the probation department compute
3 that he has remaining on his five year sentence? Do you
4 have that figured?

5 **THE PROBATION OFFICER:** Judge, I do. On Indictment
6 654, I show three years and three hundred thirty-seven
7 days. And on Indictment 20, I show three years, two
8 hundred thirty-seven days.

9 **THE COURT:** All right. That's because there were
10 one hundred twenty-eight days credit for time served on
11 Indictment 20 and twenty-eight days credit for time served
12 on 654.

13 **THE PROBATION OFFICER:** Yes, sir, plus there was a
14 year revocation --

15 **THE COURT:** Right.

16 **THE PROBATION OFFICER:** -- at some point.

17 **THE COURT:** All right. The Court finds the
18 defendant does understand the nature of these proceedings,
19 he's represented by competent counsel and this Court does
20 find that he's in violation of the terms and conditions of
21 his probation, mainly by failing to report, having
22 absconded from supervision. I'm not making any finding
23 with regard to the financial obligations because of the
24 requirement of the Spear case that such a finding be --
25 that such a violation be willful and this Court must make a

finding to that effect, and I cannot based upon the evidence before me make a finding of willfulness; but absconding from supervision and not reporting is enough for the Court to find that he is in violation of the terms and conditions of his probation. As a result of which, the Court will revoke three years on each case, to run concurrent; terminate; give him credit for the time served since December 17th, 2012.


THE PROBATION OFFICER: And can we convert the restitution to a civil judgment?
