

## ORDER

---

After being granted four extensions to serve and file the petition for a writ of certiorari in this case,<sup>1</sup> petitioner's counsel has now asked for an additional thirty day extension. The extension is granted until March 15, 2019.

This Court is concerned that the basis of this extension and other fourth and fifth extensions requested by counsel over the last five months have been based on his health. While this Court is sympathetic to counsel's medical issues, if his health will not allow him to meet the time deadlines under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules with three or fewer extensions, counsel may need to adjust his workload or take other measures to reduce the number of extensions that he is requesting.
