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1 MR. WALTON: Thank you.

2 THE COURT: I appreciate those remarks.

3 MR. WALTON: Yes, sir.

4 MS. ANDERSON: And, Your Honor, Ms. Walton does wish
5 to address you. Your Honor, we would just ask for her to
6 have to be taken into consideration her lack of record,
7 her age, and any leniency Your Honor can give and you if
8 would hear from Ms. Walton.

9 THE COURT: Ms. Walton.

10 THE DEFENDANT: I want to first just apologize to the
11 family. I cared and took care of Ms. Cook, and I would
12 have never did anything to hurt her. I know what
13 everybody said, but it's not true. I wouldn't have done
14 anything like that. I wouldn't have hurt anybody. I was
15 not only an employee at Park Pointe, I was also an
16 employee at White Oak Manner. It's a skilled facility
17 too, and they all knew me there. I would never hurt
18 anybody in my life. I don't know -- I'm unwell right now.

19 I've never had an altercation or physical fight,
20 anything like that. And I've lost my own grandmother, so
21 that's the reason I went into healthcare, to take care of
22 people. And I'm not a bad person, and I don't want you
23 all to think of me as a monster. I'm not. I would have
24 never -- I wouldn't -- and I have a son, and I was a
25 single parent to him, sir. I worked two jobs and just

1 trying to take care of him.

2 And I just don't want -- it's a lot, and I just want
3 to say I didn't speak because I felt like I didn't need
4 to, you know, to say anything, but I just -- I just didn't
5 do it, and I'm sorry, but I didn't do it. I would have
6 never hurt her. It's not in me. I would have never done
7 that. And not that I lost my family, my son.

8 And like I said, I've been here for over a year in
9 solitary, in a room because I figure I -- you know,
10 everybody would get situated out and they would, you
11 know -- they would find who this was and they just pinned
12 it on me, and I'm left here. And I just -- I just want to
13 say I would never hurt anybody. I even took care of one
14 of the correctional officer's mothers at one of -- at
15 White Oak Manner. And if Neva would -- I don't have a
16 background. You can ask the coworkers that I worked with.
17 I was not a person like that. I just wanted to speak at
18 least. And just -- that's all.

19 THE COURT: All right. I think the facts fully
20 support the verdict. And someone starts taking advantage
21 of an elderly person, forging checks, stealing their
22 money, no good is going to come out of it. Fortunately
23 rarely does it come to this end. Unfortunately in this
24 case, it did. Giving you credit on all these 354 days,
25 they're all to run concurrent, sentence on murder is life

1 in prison; burglary, 30 years; on all the others, 5 years,
2 and they're all to run concurrent. Thank you.

3 MR. BRACKETT: Thank you, Your Honor.

4 THE COURT: Anything else from the State?

5 MR. BRACKETT: No, Your Honor.

6 THE COURT: Defense?

7 MR. SMITH: No, Your Honor.

8 THE COURT: We'll stand adjourned until tomorrow
9 morning at 10:00.

1 THE COURT: We are going on the record on
2 Braquette. Braquette Wykina Walton, who was
3 tried last week and found guilty of several
4 charges including abuse and neglect resulting in
5 the death of a vulnerable adult.

6 At the end of the trial counsel for Miss
7 Walton made a motion. The motion was basically
8 that finding of death of vulnerable adult based
9 on abuse and neglect was inconsistent with the
10 finding on the murder charge in which she was
11 also found guilty. Actually very consistent and
12 not inconsistent.

13 My concern was whether or not under the
14 Blockburger test there could be successive
15 sentencing. I did some research and I
16 particularly read the case -- a case of mine out
17 of Cherokee County, the Easler case and based on
18 that I think it is clear that Miss Walton can be
19 sentenced to both murder and death of a
20 vulnerable adult based on abuse and neglect. So
21 I would sentence her this morning.

22 Anything else from the State?

23 MR. BRACKETT: No, sir, Your Honor.

24 THE COURT: Miss Anderson, anything on
25 behalf of Miss Walton?

1 MS. ANDERSON: No, Your Honor. Your Honor
2 heard the mitigation we presented. We would
3 remind Your Honor just that Miss Walton is
4 entitled to 354 days of credit and we would in
5 addition to the mitigation presented last week in
6 front of Your Honor ask for concurrent sentencing
7 on this charge.

8 THE COURT: Miss Walton, anything else you
9 wants to say.

10 THE DEFENDANT: No.

11 THE COURT: All right. Sentence is thirty
12 years to run concurrent with your sentences from
13 last Thursday. That was the first, correct?

14 MS. ANDERSON: November first, Your Honor.

15 THE COURT: All right. To run concurrent.
16 I will give you credit for you 354 four days.

17 MS. ANDERSON: Thank you, Your Honor.

18 MR. BRACKETT: Thank you, Your Honor.

I have been receiving checks from Pauline Cook since the end of July 2011/ beginning of August 2011. Ms. Cook overheard me on the phone one day talking to my mother. I was upset and she asked me what was wrong. I told her that I was coming into a financial strain and that I wasn't getting enough hours at work. Ms. Cook asked me if I had tried getting a loan from a bank or credit union. I told her that they wouldn't loan me money the small amount I needed. I told her that I needed about \$3200.00 to catch-up on some bills and to get ahead. Ms. Cook said that she didn't feel comfortable giving me a check for \$3200.00 but that she could give me small payments. I told her that I would pay her weekly until each amount was paid off. I think the first check she gave me was around \$500-\$600. That day she also made me initial a piece of paper.

The paper had our agreement written out by Ms. Cook at the top and it had my whole name and her whole name stating that she was loaning money to me and that the debt had to be paid weekly and that the debt had to be zeroed out before any other money would be given by her to me. She signed the paper and I signed it and we both dated it. She would either always pull it out of her purse or from her walker seat for me to sign off on. Under our agreement Ms Cook wrote several columns stating the date, check number and the amount of the check and I would have to initial beside the amount. After I had paid a payment or the full amount off I would sign my name beside the amount paid.

Once the balance was zeroed out she would give me another check. The last check Ms. Cook gave me was on Thursday morning before I got off work. I think it was for \$235.00 and I deposited it at the Woodforest Bank at the Wal-Mart in Tega Cay. I went to get my hair colored that morning at 10:00 AM and while my rollers were in I walked over to the bank and put it in my account all but \$50.00. That is because my hair coloring was \$21.00 and I needed to get some gas in my car as well. I think I left the salon at either 2:00pm or 2:30 pm. I went to get my son from Gold Hill Middle school and sat in the line there and after I picked him up we went home. I stopped at one of the fast food places and got him something to eat and we went home. I left for work about 10:30 pm that night and I gave Ms. Cook \$25.00 that Friday morning before I left work. I didn't have time to sign the form because the girls had run late relieving me and I had to get my son to school by 8:15 am. I gave her a \$10, 2- \$5's and 5- \$1.00's. I came back later that night about 7:30 PM to see Ms. Jackie and Marvin. The security guard was an older white man and he waved at me when we came in as I used my clicker to raise the arm up. I know him from when I had to be in the security guards orientation when they all got hired I was leaving for Greenville when Marvin called to tell me that Ms Jackie wanted to talk to me about watching her mother who was sick. My son was with me and we stopped by Park Pointe Village and talked to Ms Jackie for 20-25 minutes. I left and went to Greenville to see Desmond Wesley and his mother Ramona Wesley. 30 Mornings Drive Williamson SC is their address. I got to there house about 10-10:30 PM. We just hung out at their house. We stepped to see his cousin Charlie who is a crack head and he lives around the corner. Desmond told him to call him about doing some work. We went back to their house and drank some.

Saturday morning around 9:30-10:00 AM I got up and Desmond fixed breakfast for all of us. After that, we hung out a little and drank some beer on the lake. I left my son there and came back toward Rock Hill about 6:00PM; I know it was just starting to get dark when I left his house. I had made plans to go out with two friends (Chris & Zo) of mine in Charlotte. Chris Pearson is a friend of mine who lives in Charlotte and I've know him for over 13 years. Alonzo "Zo" is Chris's friend who lives in Atlanta; I don't know him that well.


While I was on my way back to Rock Hill, Chris called me to tell me that he couldn't make it because he had to leave town for work. I went on home and got home and got there about 9 or 9:30 PM. I didn't stay home long before I went out again to meet a guy named "Dred" in Charlotte off Brookshire/Mt. Holly area.

Dred didn't show up so I went back home and stopped in at the Sams Mart across from Cherry Park and bought a pack of Dutch Masters cigarillos and a ginger ale. I think I paid cash for it and it was around 12-12:30AM. I talked to the cashier for a moment because he was making fun of my ID because it was about to expire and he wished me happy birthday.

He is an older black male under 50 years old. I left there and went home.

The next morning I woke up and went outside to get my brown overnight bag from the car. I went to the Marathon gas station and got gas. I then stopped by the Mr. Express and got 2 Redbulls and a pack of cigarettes and went back home. Around 12:00 PM I went to Greenville and got Micah and hung out with them. Desmond wanted to wash and clean up my car for my birthday. He drove his mom's car and Micah and I rode in my Ford Focus to the car wash. Micah and Desmond washed both his moms and my car. Desmond was going to clean the inside but I told him he didn't need to because I had wiped it down that morning after I had got gas. After that, we went back to Desmond's house and Micah and I headed back to Rock Hill about 4:00 PM or 5:00 PM. We got stuck on the interstate because traffic was backed up really bad. I pulled in at a gas station to get some gas and hear that a Cop had gotten shot and that they were doing a man hunt for him. I got back to Rock Hill around 7:00 or 8:00 PM and my boyfriend, Edward Blackwell, was making cupcakes and a cake for me and cooked some chicken. I didn't eat because I felt sick to my stomach. My right arm and shoulder were also hurting because I have tendonitis in my arm.

I completed 12 years in school and I can (X) cannot () read and write.


I started working at Park Pointe back in July. The last day I worked was on Thursday night; I went in at 11 and got around 7:30. That was the last time I saw Pauline, that Friday morning when I left. I'm only part time there. Linda is the other girl who works nights; she is the full time person there. I worked that Wed and Thursday last week from 11 until about 7:30. During the summer, I worked until 8, but once my son started school, I told them that I had to leave at 7:30. On Friday, once my son Micah, got out of school, we went to Greenville to my friend Desmond's house. Leaving out to Greenville, we went by Park Pointe so that I could talk to Jackie about watching her mother during the day time. I work at night so I told her I could do it. Marvin another cook, actually called me and told me to get in contact with Jackie, she's also a cook there too. I used my black car clicker to come through the main gate. I didn't go into the building; I just talked to Jackie outside on the back loading in the back by the kitchen. Marvin was outside too. I called Marvin to tell him I was out back and they came out. From there we went down Hi-way 5 and we went to Desmond's house.

I stayed the night there on Friday night and when I woke up Saturday, Desmond cooked breakfast for us. We chilled out on the lake and drank some beer before I left. My son stayed in Greenville and I left once it started getting dark. I went back around 5:30 or 6 that evening, I was going to Charlotte to meet up with my friend, Chris' house. I was supposed to meet up with him and my friend Zo. We were going to a club named Chaser's. But when I was half way back from Greenville, Chris called me and said that he had to go out of town to Asheville to do a run. He is a supervisor for Coach America and he said that he couldn't make it for dinner. I got back to Rock Hill about an hour to an hour and a half later. I went straight home and then I changed clothes and got dressed and went to Charlotte. I left back out about 10. I was going up there to meet "Dread". That didn't work out because I thought that he was getting off work at 10 and he was going in at 10. I came back to Rock Hill and stopped at the Sam's Mart on Cherry Road to get some Dutch Masters. There was a black guy working there and it had to be before 12:45. I went home and had sex with my man because I was gone all weekend and it wouldn't have looked right. The next day, I got up and went back to pick up my son in Greenville. It was about 11:30 or 12. On my way back, we got caught up in traffic so we stopped in Gaffney and went to the truck stop. Then I took Micah to the Burger King because he said that he wanted something to eat. We got back to Rock Hill about 6 or 7. I did not go into Park Pointe on Saturday night.

I drove back from Greenville on Saturday night. I got home at about 6:30 or 7:00, it was dark so it was around that time. I got back to Park Pointe Village around 8:00, I sat in the tree room and waited for the hallways to clear. I could hear the ladies at the nursing station. When I went to the room the first time, Ms. Pauline was not there so I looked around for her bank statement. I could not locate the bank statement so I went back down to the tree house room and waited for MS. Pauline to return to her room. I heard Ms. Pauline talking and walking back up the hallway, I had to wait until the hallway was clear. I was calling the nursing station phone to see who had it and where they were. When the hallway was clear, I went down to Ms. Pauline's room. Ms. Pauline

was in the bathroom when I got there. I opened door and called out her name, I called Ms. Pauline's name and she answered from the bathroom and said that she would be out in a minute. I sat on the couch and waited for her to come out. Ms. Pauline came out and sat down on the bed and I started talking. I told her that I had cashed her checks and I told her that I was in need and I told her that I would pay her back even though she had already called the police. Ms. Pauline was upset and said "I have already called the police and you have already taken my money" and that's when she got up to call the police. Ms. Pauline went to grab the phone so I got up off the couch and said "there's no need to do that, I just want to talk to you". Ms. Pauline hit me with the phone and it fell out of her hand. We started to tussle and fell onto the bed. Ms. Pauline hit her hand on the bedside table and I kept telling her to stop because I knew that her skin would tear easily. The hand that was injured was her right hand and the injury was on the top of her hand. I was on top of her and I was trying to get her to calm down and she kept screaming "get off me, get off me". I told her that I would get off but she had to stop wailing and pulling my hair. I told her that I was not there to hurt her. Ms. Pauline stopped moving around after, I don't know how long and I checked her pulse and she did not have a pulse and I panicked. I put my head to her chest and I even checked the pulse in her feet. I did not know what to do so I sat down and I was like, I did not realize that the blood was everywhere until I turned the light on. There was blood all over the pillow and the sheet, the blood on the headboard must have come from the wailing. I was just going to leave her there, I decided that I could not leave her there like that, I used the sheet to pull her into the bathroom and I put her into the shower. I think that she was halfway in the shower; I figured that it would look like a fall. I took the sheets and put them in a clear plastic bag that was in the room. I turned the shower on and grabbed the bag with the pillows, the white sheets in the bag and I put it in the compactor beside the kitchen. I took my access card off the badge ring and I had it in my jacket pocket. I had on a blue pullover jacket with "Russell" written in red on the front, grey sweatpants and black boots. I left through the woods beside Willowbrook. I went to burger king sat there and smoked a few cigarettes. I threw the checkbook away at Burger King when Marvin called me. I did not intend to hurt Ms. Pauline. I was scared to call the police because I knew they would arrest me.






