Counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Robert Davis Smith in the Supreme Court on February 4, 2019. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Dennis Elvin Cervantes-Pavon with the Supreme Court on January 31, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Edward Isaiah Nelson in this Court on January 28, 2019. Counsel filed a petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Carmine James Miranda, III in this Court on January 22, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari, the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari pursuant to Austin v. State and accompanying appendix in the case of George A. Jones v. State in the Supreme Court on January 18, 2019. Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Daggart B. Frazier v. State in the Supreme Court on January 14, 2019. Counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Benjamin Cervantes Hernandez in the Supreme Court on January 7, 2019.


3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay.


