This responds to your letter dated March 4, 2019.

Since no appeal was taken in 2012GS08002555, I do not have any records related to that case unless they were included in the above referenced appellate court case.

Simply enter the appellate case number when you reach the search screen. The documents appear as icons next to the events in the case; simply click on the icon to open the document.

If would like this Court to provide you with a copy of all of the documents filed in Appellate Case No. 2015-001997, I can provide you with a copy of these documents for \$ 40.85. This represents the cost of copying 141 pages at our standard rate of 25 cents a page plus a mailing fee of \$ 5.60.

If you only want the lower court transcripts and any documents from the lower court that were provided to this Court in the appendix,<sup>1</sup> I can provide you with a copy of the appendix for \$ 24.45. This represents the cost of copying 85 pages at our standard rate of 25 cents a copy plus a mailing fee of \$3.20. If you desire to have these copies, please send a check or money order in the appropriate amount payable to the South Carolina Judicial Department.

Finally, I decline to forward a copy of your letter to the lower court clerk or the solicitor as you have requested.
