Dear Ms. Carter:

Please be advised that the post-judgment mediation in the above referenced matter resulted in settlement of all issues between Sea Island Food Group, LLC d/b/a Squeeze and Yaschik Development Company, Inc. d/b/a Yaschik Enterprises. It also resolved all issues as between the Michael J. Quillen Family Limited Partnership and all three (3) other parties.

In a side agreement unrelated to the mediation, the issues in this appeal between Yaschik Development Company, Inc. d/b/a Yaschik Enterprises and co-Defendants, Hilton Smith and East Bay Company, Ltd. were also resolved. Also in a side agreement, the issues between Sea Island Food Group, Inc. d/b/a Squeeze and Hilton Smith, as well as East Bay Company, Ltd. were resolved.

Consent orders reflecting these agreements are being circulated, and are or will be filed shortly.

This leaves Yaschik Development Company, Inc. d/b/a Yaschik Enterprises' appeal as to Top of the Bay, Inc. d/ba Club Light and Top of the Bay, Inc. d/b/a Club Light's cross-appeal as against Yaschik Development Company, Inc. d/b/a Yaschik Enterprises.

I believe we need a new scheduling order for dates to file Yaschik's initial appellant's brief and for TOTB to file its cross-appellant's initial brief, as the next step in the process. I believe all other parties have been or are otherwise being dismissed from the appeal.

By copy of this correspondence, I am giving notice to all parties to object if I have misstated the status of the appeal.

Please let this letter also confirm our conversation of this morning, wherein you advised that this appeal remains stayed at this time, and initial briefs are not due tomorrow.

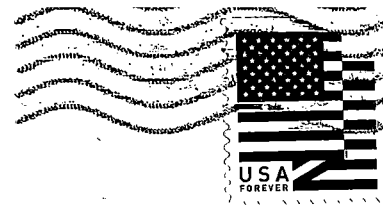
