Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$250.00.
- The notice of appeal does not comply with Rule 203(a), SCACR. Specifically, it must contain the names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all attorneys of record and the names of the party or parties represented by each.
- Et al may not be used in the caption.
- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR and specifically state to whom the document was served and which respondent that counsel represents. Our records indicate you must include Brandon Michael Briggs, Esquire, as a counsel of record.
