Jenny, I just left you a voicemail relating to the attached Remittitur. I represent Amisub in this CON appeal filed by Charlotte Mecklenburg Hospital Authority (“CHS”). After the Court of Appeals affirmed the ALC decision and denied the appeal, the SC Supreme Court granted cert and remanded. The Court of Appeals again affirmed the ALC decision and the Supreme Court denied cert. We received the Remittitur today.

SC Code 44-7-220B requires that a party appealing an ALC decision to approve a CON must post a bond. It also provides that if the Court of Appeals affirms the ALC decision “the Court of Appeals shall award to the party whose project is the subject of the appeal all of the bond” and also may award fees and costs.
