According to Rule 203 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, a Notice of Appeal must include the name of the court from which the appeal is taken; the judge's name; the lower court docket number; the date of the order being appealed; the name of the appealing party; and the names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all the attorneys of record and the names of the party or parties represented by each. A copy of the order being challenged on appeal, proof of service showing the notice has been timely served upon the respondent and the Administrative Law Court, and a filing fee of \$250.00 must accompany the Notice of Appeal.
