- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The appellant's initial brief does not comply with Rule 208, SCACR. Specifically, the appellant's initial brief must contain the following: Table of Contents and Cases, Statement of Issues on Appeal, Statement of the Case, Standard of Review, Argument, and Conclusion.
