ORDER

After careful consideration, Appellant's motion for the appointment of counsel is denied. *See State v. Clinkscales*, 318 S.C. 513, 515, 458 S.E.2d 548, 549 (1995) ("A defendant's Sixth Amendment right to assistance of counsel attaches at all critical stages of a criminal prosecution. However, this constitutional right extends only to the first right of appeal." (citations omitted)). Appellant is permitted to file only one original unbound copy of the record on appeal and the final briefs. The front cover must have Appellant's name and address. Appellant must still serve Respondent with a copy of all filings and file a proof of service with this court. Appellant's record and final briefs must be served and filed within thirty days of the date of this order or this appeal may be dismissed.
