Dear Mr. Stewart:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- We note the notice of appeal was filed in part by Beverley D. Wilson, M.D., as pro se power of attorney for the appellant. Our records reflect that Dr. Wilson is not an attorney licensed to practice law in South Carolina. Therefore, all filings with the court must be signed either by Travis G. Stewart on his own behalf, or by an attorney licensed to practice law in this state.
- You must serve and file an amended notice of appeal removing your argument. The notice of appeal should be substantially in the format shown in Appendix to Part II of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. The notice of Appeal shall include only that information as described in Rule 203, SCACR.

- The proof of service does not reflect the date of service of the document. You must provide an amended proof of service for the notice of appeal filed with this office on Friday, March 15, 2019. You must also provide proof of service for the amended notice of appeal.
