How are you doing? Fine I hope & pray. I feel like my case falls under the S.C. Code of laws & the code # 44-53-460 allows for a reduced sentence in an accommodation sale. In State v Cobb, 355 S.C. 98, 584 S.E. 2d 371 (2003), the Court held that the defendant's conduct in that case constituted an accommodation & remanded the case for sentencing under the accommodation statute. At the Conclusion my Atty, Robert Pachak stated that my case should be remanded for resentencing under the accommodation statute. This was dated on 14th day of May, 2014. Also stated, he has, pursuant to Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S. Ct. 1396 (1967), briefed an arguable legal issue which arose during the course of the trial. I feel like my case should have been time served with probation. The Bennettville Courts have never given me probation. But other people in that town that get caught with drugs. They give them drug court & probation. I want to be treated fair too. I hope & pray that the South Carolina Court of Appeals will please let me go home. My health is not too good & I have a plate with 9 screws in my right shoulder. My Doctor wants to put a rotate cap in my arm to relieve the pain.
