MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO ALLOW
THE COURT'S CONSIDERATION OF APPELLANT'S MOTION TO REMAND

Pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR, Appellant Carolina Water Service, Inc. ("CWS") moves for an extension of time to serve and file Appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be included in the Record on Appeal ("Designation of Matter"). On March 22, 2019, CWS filed a motion to remand this case to the South Carolina Public Service Commission.
