Dear Ms. Kitchings:

My apologies, but I have a very critical question for this court which entails 2 parts.

There are fifteen (15) Orders on appeal. Do I file a brief for EACH Order? I have been drafting it as such since there are 10 respondents and none of the orders include all of the respondents, instead some with a minimum of one (1) and others with a max of five (5).

If only one (1) brief is allowed, then that Brief will have to include all 15 orders and all issues on appeal.

My predicament is such. I understand the South Carolina Appellate Court Rule 208(b)(5) states the length of the initial brief is not to exceed (50) pages, and reply briefs shall not exceed (25) pages. I'm more than certain an average of 3.33-pages for each Order will not be adequate or attainable.

It further states that, on motion, the Appellate Court may grant a party permission to exceed those limitations, but I have no idea [until a draft is accomplished on each Order] the amount of pages the brief may actually be, and therefore cannot file a motion requesting to exceed 50 pages if I'm not sure what will be asked of this court.

To further note, this court is currently considering my motion requesting additional time to file the initial brief BUT until I have clear direction (i.e., how many briefs or how many pages I'm allowed), then it appears it is impossible to compose or format a proper brief or briefs.

I would respectfully ask this court for its guidance.
