WHEREFORE, the Defendant is committed to the State Department of Corrections County Detention Center, for a determinate term of 25-25 days/months/years or under the Youthful Offender Act not to exceed 25 years and/or to pay a fine of \$200.00; provided that upon the service of 25-25 days/months/years and or payment of \$; plus costs and assessments as applicable*; the balance is suspended with probation for months/years and subject to South Carolina Department of Probation, Parole and Pardon Services standard conditions of probation, which are incorporated by reference.
