MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Christian Coleman respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until April 22, 2019**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Christian Coleman respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Gabriel Gratto v. The State with this Court on February 14, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Jovan Mitchell v. The State with this Court on January 22, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Timothy Beheler v. The State with this Court on January 22, 2019.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for filing the petition be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


