• In Effective Assistance of Counsel[s], L. King Co. 239/16 B North Brooks street, Manning, S.C. 29102 and Thompson Kinney - Lee County Public Defender, 1308 Broad street, Camden, S.C. 29020; Based on the Facts that Both Counsel[s] only visited with Client a total of not more than (6) six times out of my (5) five, (2) Two month incarceration and inpatient Evaluation and Treatments; Furthermore, Counsel Failed to Advise the Legallities of what they knew or should have known of the case to include mental Health critieria and the like for defenses and/or for sentence consideration, Praubable Cause and/or Fruits of A Pbisinous tree. (The Fruits came from the alleged traffic stop that Defendant was Never cited for during or anytime thereafter Alleged incidents, Nor was there any citation for a Resisting Arrest offense and the like...).

Attorney ERroneously misled Appellant to believe He could not withdraw a Plea before the Hearing date because Attorney advised Appellant that he already signed and agreed to go forward (3) Three months prior to the Hearing date, so Attorney advised Appellant He must go through with the Plea on the Sentencing date.

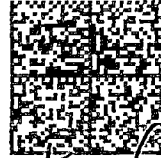
